TARGETED at the sophisticated home cinema-owner who is concerned not only with sound quality, but also with style, these speakers look like they belong in a millionaire mansion and will go a long way towards earning the respect of your snobby mates. There is something timeless about their appearance, and we think you'll still be gathering compliments ten years down the road.

The sound they produce is superb. The HiForce 1 subwoofer thunders out rich, clear bass even at high volumes, and the "Acoustic Damping Tube" technology that has been incorporated into the satellites ensures that mid-range frequencies are damped at source; sound distortion and power handling are both noticeably improved as a result of the ADT tech, too.

DVDs were a pleasure to watch using this set, we ended up feeling like we were in a proper cinema the sound was so impressive. Music quality was similarly pleasurable, and AC/DC's *Thunderstruck* blew us and our neighbours away.

There is very little not to recommend these speakers over, bar

price. At over R5 000 per satellite (yes, you read that correctly), you're looking at almost R30 000 before you've even looked at the subwoofer, which will cost you a further R8 500. If you're looking for high-end sound for your home cinema and a large chunk of loose change, these speakers are a damn fine investment.**DD**
